



Code of Conduct

In addition to Basketball Victoria's Code of Conduct our club has rules which need to be followed to ensure we have a safe and enjoyable environment for both Coaches and Players.

- 1) Players and parents need to show respect at all times to coaches, players, officials and spectators. This includes listening, no bad language, no unsportsmanlike conduct or aggressive behaviour
- 2) Playing Basketball is a commitment to both attending training and games.
- 3) Players should arrive at least 10 minutes before scheduled games. This gives the children time to sign the scoresheet, chat with coach and warm up before the game to avoid injuries.
- 4) Team Managers/Coaches must be informed in advance if players are unable to play or train so that substitute arrangements can be made.
- 5) No food or chewing gum during training sessions (other than water, which is preferred for players).

Where there is a behaviour issue at training, (which will be addressed with Parents) the player will not be allowed to play their game on Saturday.

We require parent and player acceptance of the code of conduct so there is full understanding of rules and acceptable behaviour.

Our aim is to conduct skills and fitness based training sessions which lead to Basketball Games which encourage team work.

Terms & Conditions

- 1) I will not under any circumstances hold the Club liable for any accident or injury which may occur. In the event of any illness or incident where it is impracticable to communicate with me, I authorise a representative of the Club obtaining such medical or other assistance as my child may require. This may include the request for specialised services, such as Ambulance, for which I agree to pay all associated costs.

- 2) I agree that my child/children and myself as a parent member will abide by the Rules and Policies of the St Paul's Warriors Basketball Club, and the Basketball Victoria Codes of Conduct in relation to Players, Coaches, Parents and Spectators.
- 3) I agree to take care of the uniform and return it if my child ceases to play for the club. If the uniform is lost or damaged I agree to pay the replacement costs
- 4) I agree to contribute to the organisation of my child/children's team/s by scoring when rostered or undertaking alternative tasks as agreed with the Team Manager
- 5) I grant permission for the use of an image or recording of my child which appears in a photo, film and/or audio recording to publish on paper and/or on our club's website
- 6) I understand that registration fees must be paid in full by Round 3 of the season otherwise my child may not be permitted to play
